Arrival

- from **Monday 15 July** at the earliest. (Exception: participation in events prior to this date)
- **Before setting up**, you must ask the organisers for your own campsite, which will be allocated according to the details in your registration form.
- **Setting up without prior instruction and/or unauthorised access to the site will result in immediate exclusion from the event!** Therefore: It is better to ask too many questions! - Together we will find a solution.
- **Emergency number: +494361-623142** This number is always forwarded to a member of the organisation.
- Registrations take place at the following times:
Monday: 10am – 12 p.m.; 4 p.m. – 8 p.m.
Thursday: 8 - 10 a.m.; 4 - 8 p.m.
Friday: from 9 a.m.

Set-up and take-down

- The museum is in operation, therefore set-up can only take place at the following times:
Monday: from 10:00 a.m., all day
Tuesday - Wednesday: 8 - 10 a.m.; from 5 p.m. (for those travelling to camps already present)
Thursday: 8 - 10 a.m., from 5.00 p.m.
Friday: from 8:00 a.m., all day
- Access to the museum areas only for set-up and dismantling after consultation with the organisation
- The parking of vehicles on the site must be kept as short as possible.
- Vehicles must be removed from the site immediately after set-up.
- The marked boundaries of the storage area must be strictly adhered to.
- Take-down is possible at the following times:
Sunday: from 18:00
Monday: all day
Tuesday-Sunday: before 10:00 a.m., from 5:00 p.m.

Camp location

- The market area is reserved for camps with demonstrating craftsmen, traders and other visitor offers (hands-on activities, etc.); other camps will be distributed to neighbouring areas of the museum.
- Organise your camp as space-saving as possible!

Stay

- The camp is to be kept authentic (without visible modern objects) and revitalised during museum opening hours. The opening hours are:
Tuesday-Sunday: 10:00 - 17:00
Days of the Slavs (Sat. & Sun.): 10:00 - 18:00
- The activities specified on your application must be carried out during the Days of the Slavs. If you are staying longer, we would be very grateful for appropriate visitor offers outside the Days of the Slavs.
- Please do not dispose your rubbish in the visitor rubbish bins, but in the containers provided for this purpose.
- If you arrive before 19 July, please take part in cleaning the toilets. The organisers will work out a cleaning plan with you.

Not permitted during opening hours

- Modern clothing or objects visible on the person or in the camp (e.g. mobile phones, plastic, cardboard, camping crockery, sunglasses etc.), but also wooden shoes and plug-in chairs. Exceptions are modern aids (e.g. glasses, walking aids etc.) on which you are dependent.
- Inappropriate representations that differ significantly from those in the application
- Consumption of alcohol and intoxicants before and during museum opening hours

- Smoking visible to visitors in medieval clothing (please use the smoking area behind the kitchen or go into your tent)
- Permanently empty camps

Generally not allowed in our museum:

- Anti-constitutional symbols - in particular swastikas in all variations (regardless of direction, number of spokes, square/round etc.) and all variations based on them, such as the "Black Sun" or "Ręce boga". The archaeological find does not matter!
- Distributing illegal goods and media that are harmful to minors or passing them on to minors
- Intolerant and anti-constitutional statements

Parking / shuttle service

- The small car park opposite the museum car park can be used until Friday afternoon
- From Friday afternoon, ALL vehicles must be removed from the event car parks and taken to the performers' car parks.
- The museum's shuttle service to the performers' car parks runs on Friday afternoon and Sunday evening. The exact times will be announced by the organisers when the parking spaces are allocated. Please leave a note with your name and telephone number (handed out by the organisers) clearly visible behind the windscreen at the car park for performers
- In case of emergencies, please contact the organisers and we will take you to your vehicles.

Fire

- Only within the permitted areas (will be communicated by the organisers when setting up)
- Minimum distance of 1.5 metres to tents
- Only excavated pits, table food or clay-covered food - NO fire bowls!
- The fire pits are to be backfilled after the end of the camp.
- Only charcoal or wood as fuel (no fossil fuels such as fat or hard coal)
- Firewood can be found in the shelters to the right of the toilet building ("Backstage")
- Fire extinguishers are distributed around the site for emergencies.

Dogs

- Leashes are compulsory on the entire museum grounds!
- Any dog waste must be removed by the owner.

Range of goods

- Goods for sale must be labelled in accordance with the Price Indication Ordinance of 18 October 2002 (BGBl I, p. 4197).
- Commercial traders must carry their trade licence with them and show it on request.

Domiciliary rights

The Wallmuseum Oldenburg in Holstein gemeinnützige Betreibergesellschaft mbH is the sole organizer of the Days of the Slavs. The instructions of the organizer and his authorized representatives must be followed. In case of non-compliance, we reserve the right to take appropriate measures, up to and including a ban from the site.

Force majeure

In the event of force majeure (storms, natural disasters, etc.), the organiser reserves the right to cancel the event. In this case, the organiser cannot be held liable for any damages, costs incurred or lost earnings or be obliged to pay compensation.

Changes

Due to permits from the authorities or other necessities, there may unfortunately always be changes to the programme in the run-up to the Slavic Days. We will keep you up to date regarding the requirements for the event and will provide you with the necessary information in good time before your arrival.
